

## Technical Activities highlights

The 6th **IHTC 2024 Multi Regional conference** has been held in Bari, Italy. November 27-30 with great success:

436 attendees. 23.5% of them from industry and governmental/intergovernmental organizations and 17.5% professional engineers.

## Technical Activities highlights

**Multi-regional (R7-R8-R10) “Why Standards matters Workshop”** at IEEE Conference on Standards for Communications and Networking (CSCN 2024) and in conjunction with TELFOR 2024 (R8 FCS conference), 25 November, 2024, organized by R8 Standard ad hoc Committee

The **Robot Championship** was held in Malta (23/24 November 2024). 11 R8 Sections had representatives; 5 webinars were organized with over 80 participants; 14 awards categories for this championship were assigned.





Reg 8 Submissions by Year and Conference Type









# Overview of Chapters in IEEE Region 8

## Member Count – IEEE Region 8 Top Ten Societies




# Overview of Chapters in IEEE Region 8

Societies Represented in Region 8 Sections – Top Ten










# The Region 8 PEA Flash-talks

## New Initiative



### ***STEM for Sustainable Development: Empowering Communities in Underserved Areas through Innovation***

Together with Regions 3, 4, 6 and 10 the joint proposal was submitted for consideration for 2025 MGA surplus funding.

Project Lead Names from Region 8: Dalius Navakauskas and Jenipher Ogara.

In the proposal, two new localized programs are envisioned to be implemented:

- ▶ Tech Ignite STEM Summer Camp (Kenya).
- ▶ Bridging the Gap: Pre-University STEM Outreach for Tanzania's Industrial Growth (Tanzania).

Long-term impact. These events can raise awareness about the importance of technology and engineering and their societal impact, attracting the attention of local governments, schools, and industries to IEEE. Eventually, the project could catalyze a supportive ecosystem for technology innovation in underserved areas and contribute to the growth of their tech sectors. Additionally, experiences from different Sections can be shared through shared activities among project members to develop more impactful IEEE projects. For example, Kenya and Tanzania can share experiences on sustainable technologies for mining industries, while the Southeastern US, Sri Lanka and Indonesia focus on AI-driven entrepreneurship.
