Progress against goals since the last report

1. Efficient management of the CoCC

We increased the number of training events, with participation from CEE.

CoCC meetings were held regularly every month (except August) with detailed minutes containing task distribution and reports on activities.

All CoCC documents are available to all members and VC-TA in a dedicated google drive folder.

2. Timely review of the financial and technical co-sponsorship (TCS/FCS) requests and conc unit approval

From April 2025:

5 R8 FCS and TCS requests have been approved for 2025 and 4 for 2026.

5 requests of Conc. Unit. evaluation have been approved, 1 declined, 2 in progress.

3. Ensure success of the R8 flagship conferences: call for bids, support, oversight

The organization process of each flagship/portfolio conference is supervised from the application form check list to the final report submission and budget control.

The R8 steering committees are working with the organizers to supervise and give support.

The steering committees of conferences held in previous years have worked with the organizers to close the pending actions (R8 final reports and final financial report, best practices and lessons learned documents).

Several R8 flagship and portfolio conferences (EUROCON 2025, RTSI 2025, IHTC 2025, HISTELCON 2025) were held successfully.

The steering committees of AFRICON 2025 (10-12 December 2025, Polokwane, South Africa (<https://2025.ieee-africon.org/>)) is meeting very regularly.

The 2026 R8 flagship conferences (MELECON 2026, RTSI 2026, ENERGYCON 2026) MoUs are done or underway (RTSI, ENERGYCON).

MELECON 2026 is at an advanced stage of organization. Also the organization of 2026 R8 FCS conferences EDUCON and WiSEE, both in cooperation with IEEE Societies/Councils, is in progress, MoU signed and liaisons are following the status of advancement.

We postponed the decision about this committees because many representatives are not yet defined and we need the feedback from R7 and R9

An annex to the original agreement for HISTELCON which was signed by four Regions: R7, R8, R9 and R10 has been proposed by the R8 VC-TA, to solve the problem of superposition of two multi-region conferences (IHTC 2029 and HISTELCON 2029) in the same region (R9).

The annex reports a change in the organizing Regions of HISTELCON 2028 and 2029.

The update refers to the HISTELCON 2028 which will be organized in R9 and HISTELCON 2029 which will be organized in R8.

4. Increase IEEE R8 visibility through conferences

The cooperation with the other R8 TA Committees (AfI, ChCC, Climate Change, Standard), R8 MA Committees (YP, WIE, LM, HA, MD, ...) and R8 SAC has been fruitful, and many special events/ panels/ workshops/ competitions have been organized during EUROCON 2025, RTSI 2025 and HISTELCON 202, attracting more participants: from industry, students and YPs.

5. Support the sections' conference coordinators, section chairs and IEEE R8 TCS/FCS Conference organizers
