### Goals

### 1. Support and Promote New Chapters in Region 8

- O Support formation of new chapters & student chapters in Region 8.
- o Identify formation opportunities within Sections.
- o KPI: Increase in the number of chapters in Region 8.

## 2. Support Existing Chapters with increased Vitality and Event Activity

- o Reactivation of dormant chapters and those with no report submission and/or activities.
- o Providing guidance and advice to chapters on collaborative events, society events, and conferences.
- KPI: Increase in the number of reported events on IEEE vTools for 2025 + 2026, decrease in the 'dissolved' chapters list.

### 3. Region 8 Chapter Awards

- o Promote and evaluate the Chapter of the Year Awards.
- o KPI: Completed awards procedure to deadline.

## 4. Events and Training

- Organisation of interactive training events and outreach activities, such as the Chapter Panorama information sessions and the in-person Volunteer Leadership Training.
- o KPI: Successful organisation and high attendance at organised events.

### Progress against goals since the last report

## 1. Support and Promote New Chapters in Region 8

- Regularly provide guidance on chapter formation process and requirements to section and potential chapter leaders through interactive training events.
- Construct regular reports on potential chapter formation opportunities for distribution to Section leaders.
- Engage with Society and Division leadership to identify potential chapter opportunities.
- See 'R8 Chapter Coordination Statistics & Trends' for current chapter data.

## 2. Support Existing Chapters with increased Vitality and Event Activity

- Contact, promote and encourage all active chapters to meet the chapter vitality requirements, including maintaining an active committee, submitting vTools event reports and encouraging membership development.
- Generate a 'short-list' of at-risk chapters, based on vTools Events submission data, systematically contacting chapter and section leadership to ensure that chapters remain active and avoid dissolution.
- Inspire chapter leaders by showcasing the best performing OUs, showing innovative events, membership activities and professional development opportunities around the Region.
- Address the probation list with urgency, to ensure that chapters avoid dissolution at all costs.
- Engage with Society and Division leadership for collaboration on chapter vitality in Region 8.
- Promotion of vTools event reporting deadline via all channels.

### 3. Region 8 Chapter Awards

- Promotion of participation in Region 8 Chapter of the Year Awards.
- Oversee award evaluation tasks within ChCC team together on completion of awards campaign.

# 4. Events and Training

- Regularly host online and in-person chapter training events (UK and Ireland, Benelux, Tunisia)
- Organise three-day 'Chapter Panorama' event, showcasing the best performing chapters in Region 8.
- Co-organise flagship 'Volunteer Leadership Training' event with 24 confirmed in-person attendees.



# **Committee of R8 Specific Issues**

- 1. Knowledge of IEEE Chapter vitality requirements
  - Some sections still have little understanding of their chapter portfolio.
  - o **Proposal**: Increase promotional activities, outreach and communication.
- 2. Chapter Training Enhancements:
  - Need for more targeted training sessions for chapter chairs.
  - o Proposal: Introduce topic-specific training sessions, such as vTools, OU Analytics, Funding, Events, etc.

## **Points of Concern**

- 1. Ensuring continuous participation in chapter activities.
- 2. Maintaining chapter vitality in under-represented sections.
