115th IEEE Region 8 Committee Meeting, November 2020

Report of R8 LMAGs activities

I- Administration status:

- i- R8 has 14 LMAGs (the second) after the R10 (15 LMAGs) and before the R5 (13 LMAGs),
- ii- Result of sending letters, on July 2020 to chairs of the R8 sections having more than 30 LMs asking them to create a LMAG in their sections: a petition is started in the Portugal Section while Austria, Swede and Denmark Sections showed their interest in this subject.
- iii- No R8 LMAG was dissolved.

II- Activities in 2020

i) France LMAG:

- 1- organized a very successful Virtual conference on 09 June 2020 about Artificial Intelligence: Scientific basic elements and ethics questions, presented by Professor *Raja Chatila* (there were 75 registrations for the event from all France cities, all Europe and even from Middle East),
- 2- organized its Second Virtual Meeting on 20 October 2020 from 05h00 pm to 17h00pm. Title "The great André-Marie Ampère and the 200 years of electromagnetism", By: Philippe Ponchon, Administrator of SAAMA, « Société des Amis d'André-Marie Ampère ». Number of of participants 36 from all France cities and all Europe.

ii) Switzerland LMAG and Italy LMAG:

- 1- Participate in the IEEE Day Online Virtual Celebration with their YP Operating units and the <u>Ecole Polytechnique Federale de Lausanne</u>, on 6 October 2020 from 06:00 PM to 08:30 PM.
- 2- Representatives of the Life Members and History activities of Switzerland and Italy brought up a session around the theme of The microchip revolution. For more details see: https://events.vtools.ieee.org/m/239910

iii) UK & Ireland LMAG:

- 1- October 14th: Review meeting on the progress of 4 Milestone proposals. One has been approved, one is being assessed, one is being submitted, and one is in a preliminary state of preparation. The unveiling ceremony for the first Milestone had to be postponed until 2021.
- **2- November 25th**: Webinar on Robotics by Professor Kaspar Althoefer, Queen Mary, University of London.

iv) <u>Lebanon LMAG</u>:

- 1- In 2019, a US\$32,079 grant was awarded by the IEEE Foundation for to the IEEE Lebanon Section's Life Member Affinity Group in IEEE Region 8 for its project " SET-Souq ETaqa (Energy Info Market)" to support an awareness campaign to education the general public on sustainable green energy solutions to solve the perpetual power deficit in Lebanon. - 2- Lebanon LMAG had couple of ZOOM meetings for the LMAG Committee. However, these activities never stopped as far as the Souk e-Taqa IEEE Foundation Grant was concerned. Our preparatory work was almost on daily basis through e-mails, telephone calls and WhatsApp messages. We interviewed six individuals (face to face and ZOOM) for possible hiring. We visited companies personally or contacted them by e-mail. We received 8 offers for Branding/Website design/ Social presence and campaign. Currently we are at a stage of choosing one of the offers. Therefore the rest of this year will be dedicated to the implementation of the Grant.
- 3- As far as technical or professional activities not related to the Grant, it is possible to arrange for a WEBINAR. Lectures are not possible due to the following reasons:
 - a) High schools are closed (online education with unproven success)
 - b) Universities have restrictions and the education process was online.
 - c) Electrical outages last month was severe
 - d) COVID19 pandemic and closures effected the possibility of local presentations.

v) Israel LMAG:

Two meetings:

- 1- 12 August 2020 : Title : Light rail systems, by Efi Kalifa of NTA Ltd
- 2- 7 September 2020 : Robotic Process Automation, by Dudi Karmi of EY Company

vi) Remarks:

- I- Due to the present difficult situation resulting from COVID-19:
 - i) it was not easy for LMAGs to make significant use of the larger allocations for Life member activities of up to a maximum of \$2,000 each year,
 - ii) For France LMAG: three F2F meetings planned on 10-03-2020, 08-05-2020 and 23-06-2020 were cancelled,

- iii) Joint F2F meeting organized by the Switzerland LMAG and the Italy LMAG planned to be held on March 31, 2020 in Lugano at the Switzerland Scientific Computing Center was cancelled,
- iv) The Benelux LMAG intends to organize virtual meetings. A few of their members attended the 2 meetings organized by the French section in June and October and reported about it. They are looking for suitable topics and speakers.

III- Strategy for 2020

- i) Elevation of the Ad-hoc Life Members Subcommittee to Life Members Affinity Groups (LMAGs) Sub Committee ». as it is difficult for only one active member (responsible of AD-hoc committee) to coordinate the possible promising activities of our 14 LMAGs. Also I underline that the task of the LM coordinator includes organizing our own Regional events, not relying exclusively on what it is done by the Sections. I already sent a proposal to R8 OpCom concerning this issue
- ii) A top priority is to facilitate the use of Webex for Life member meetings (due to CODIV-19) and also to reduce the running costs and make it easier to connect members living away from the main urban centers,
- iii) LMAGs should encourage members to apply for the special projects grants available from the Life Member Fund and the IEEE Foundation,
- iv) The inclusion of older members approaching LM status, together with retired members, would transform the viability of the smaller LMAGs.
