

Germany LMAG meets quarterly

LMAG Germany is a very active organization holding meetings every three months. Due to the fact that the membership comes from all parts of Germany (Hamburg in the north, Munich in the south), all meetings have been online events so far. The typical attendance is some 30 people. The programme of the meetings usually consists of two presentations (see below) with a Q&A session after the talk and open discussions about a variety of other issues. Currently, based on a proposal by the LMAG members, the acknowledgment process of an IEEE milestone is under way. The following is a list of the most recent presentations held during LMAG meetings (topics mostly freely translated from German):

- May 30, 2023: Semiconductors for use in vehicles – the road ahead (M. Wahl) and Introduction to neural networks (M. Klingner)
- Feb 28, 2023: E-mobility: some practical user experience (U. Reimers) and Charging infrastructure for E-mobility (K.-U. Stein)
- Nov 30, 2022: Software defined RADAR (W. Wiesbeck) and Introduction to the IEEE milestone programme (P. Russer)
- Aug 31, 2022: History and future of 100% renewable energy (K.-U. Stein)

The next meeting has already been scheduled. It will take place on 29 August 2023. We will hear presentations about renewable energies and, related to this, aspects of climate change.
