The total number of dedicated <u>Milestones in Region 8</u> (.xlsx) is currently 64, with 66 plaques located in 18 Sections: UK and Ireland (21); Italy (9); France (7); Germany (6); Benelux (4); Israel, Poland, Russia (Northwest), Spain, Switzerland (2); Croatia, Denmark, Hungary, Norway, Serbia and Montenegro, South Africa, Sweden, and Ukraine (1). Note that France and UK and Ireland have one Milestone (#44) in common, with different citations on the plaques, and that one of the Milestones in Poland (#205) has a duplicate plaque in Germany. Multiple plaques for the same Milestone in the same Section are not added to the count.

In addition to the actual Milestones, there are 2 Special Citations: one in Serbia and Montenegro (Belgrade) and one in Germany (Paderborn).
